The Find Me Service Web-browser-based interface allows you to manage your own dialing plan and service settings.

This feature has the following requirements:


- Your computer must have a Windows-based operating system and the Internet Explorer Web browser.
- The subscriber's Web browser must have ActiveX enabled.

Note: Windows and ActiveX are registered trademarks of the Microsoft Corporation.

The Find Me web interface is divided into two tabs - Dialing Plan and Configuration.

Dialing Plan

The Dialing Plan tab contains a list of phone numbers that the Find Me service will dial while trying to locate you.

The dialing plan may contain up to six entries. The properties associated with each phone number in the Dialing Plan are described below:

Action	Determines the order in which the phone numbers will be dialed. If the same Action number appears in the list more than once, all phone numbers with the Action number will be dialed simultaneously.
Number To Dial	10-digit phone number to be dialed. The same phone number may be listed multiple times in the Dialing Plan.
Verify	This is set to Yes if the service should verify that you are present when the number is answered.
Wait For Answer	Maximum number of seconds (1-60) the service should wait for an answer before moving on to the next action.
Delay	Number of seconds (0-60) the service should wait before dialing the number.

To Add an Entry to the Dialing Plan:

1. Click the Add button located below the Dialing Plan list.
2. Select an Action number.
3. Enter the Number To Dial.
4. Check Yes or No in the Verify field.
5. Enter the number of seconds to wait for an answer.
6. Enter the number of seconds to delay calling.
7. If the field is available, check Yes or No in the Allow Call Forwarding field.
8. Click OK to add the new entry to the dialing plan, or click Cancel to discard the entry.
9. Click Save Changes.

To Edit Rows in the Dialing Plan:

1. Double-click the row or select the row and click Edit.
2. Make changes to the properties in the window.
3. Click OK to apply those changes to the dialing plan or click Cancel to discard changes and exit the window.
4. Click Save Changes.

To Delete Rows from the Dialing Plan:

1. Select the row and click Delete or right-click on the row and select Delete.
2. A confirmation window will appear. Click Yes to continue with the deletion, or click No to cancel the deletion.
3. If you click Yes, the row will be removed from the Dialing Plan, but it will remain 'active' until you click Save Changes.

Configuration

The Configuration tab is used to display and edit the general service settings. Changes to fields in the Configuration tab become active after clicking the Save Changes button.

The following fields are found in the configuration tab:

Name	Your name or some other descriptive information about the you. This is a 30-character optional field.
PIN	4-digit number you use to manage your settings. The default PIN is 0000.
Name Announcement Recorded	This box is checked if you have recorded your name for playback to the calling party. This field is read-only and is updated when your data is transferred. You must record your name for the service to operate.
Play "Searching For Party" Announcement	This box is checked if the "Searching For Party" announcement should be played to the calling party while the service executes the dialing plan.
"Searching For Party" Announcement Delay	Number of seconds to wait before playing the "Searching For Party" announcement.
